

Cain Denture Center Financial Policy

Thank you for choosing our office for your denture needs. We realize that every person's financial situation is different. For this reason, we have worked hard to provide a variety of payment options to help you receive the denture care you need and deserve that allows you to enjoy a healthy, beautiful smile with respect to your budget. Denture treatment is an excellent investment in an individual's medical and psychological care. We are always available to answer your questions or assist you in any way we can.

To maintain the practice operations and prevent potential misunderstandings, we ask patients to accept and adhere to the following financial arrangements regarding their denture treatment.

Optional Payment Terms:

1. **Full Pay DOS:** For most treatment, payment in full (cash, check or card) at the time of service. We will still file your insurance and payment will go directly to you the patient.
2. **Major Service - Two Payment Option:** We offer a two-payment option for new denture treatment. We ask that you pay one-half of your payment at the first appointment and the second half at the seat date appointment. We will still file your insurance and payment will go directly to you the patient.
3. **Credit Card Payment Option:** We allow (with a signed agreement form and established payment history with our office), a Credit Card Payment Option, which allows you to make three equal installments by credit card. One-third payment is due at the first appointment, one-third is due thirty days later, and the remaining one-third is due sixty days from the initial appointment. Our office personnel will charge these payments to your credit card on the due dates.

Payments are expected at the time services are rendered. We accept cash, checks, debit cards, and all major credit cards.

Broken appointments: A specific amount of time is reserved especially for you and we strongly encourage all patients to keep their appointments. If you must change your appointment, we require at least 24 hours notice to avoid a \$35.00/hour cancellation fee (emergencies are an exception).
